

Visions and Revelations Message 4: “The One Who Bore the Prince of Life”

We should be impressed by how much grace and love God has towards us, “the rebellious ones”. He chose Mary, a woman of a rebellious race, whose very name means “rebellious one”, to conceive our Lord and Savior. This is a picture of God’s desire to use fallen man to carry out His purpose. Brothers and sisters, this should make us joyful! God has such grace on us! However, in our Christian lives we may experience the Lord’s peace, His mercy, His grace, His love, His tenderness, His kindness, but we don’t experience His joy.
